FAQ – EXHIBITOR COMPRESSED AIR SERVICES

WHAT TYPE OF COMPRESSED AIR CONNECTION IS PROVIDED?

Vancouver Convention Centre will provide a 1/4" Automotive Type C Quick connection.

WHAT IS THE PSI / SCFM PROVIDED?

At the Vancouver Convention Centre our tanks will provide 11.5SCFM @ 40 PSI or 10.2 SCFM @ 90 PSI and will strive to provide you with a constant and reliable PSI/SCFM; however, due to location and distance of the connection, we cannot guarantee it will be the desired PSI/SCFM.

WHERE IS COMPRESSED AIR AVAILABLE?

Compressed air at the Vancouver Convention Centre comes from floor ports located on a 30' grid on the West Exhibit Hall floor only. Exhibitors should contact their show manager for master plans showing their booth location and its relation to the Vancouver Convention Centre floor ports.

IS THE PRICE FOR COMPRESSED AIR "PER DAY" OR "PER SHOW"?

Compressed air prices are "per show". Moves or changes to the location of compressed air that has already been installed may result in additional labour charges.

CAN I ADD AN ADDITIONAL AIR SERVICE?

Additional connections are only applicable at a booth that has already ordered the initial connection. Separate booths are to be ordered as a new initial connection. On-site additions must be reviewed to determine if it is possible to add a new connection or not.

Not all on-site air service requests are guaranteed if access is not possible.

CAN I RUN MY OWN COMPRESSED AIR HOSE?

Yes, as long as the hose has a 1/4" automotive type C quick connection and has had a proper safety check to ensure there are no holes, tears or leaks.

WHEN WILL MY COMPRESSED AIR BE INSTALLED?

Compressed Air will be installed before the show opens. In most cases, Vancouver Convention Centre attempts to have Compressed Air set at the exhibitor's booth prior to their arrival.

DO YOU OFFER 24 HOUR COMPRESSED AIR?

Yes, once installed your Compressed Air will remain on 24 hours a day.

WHERE WILL MY COMPRESSED AIR BE LOCATED?

Typically Compressed Air will be located along the back wall of the booth, on the floor.
